Explorers Ages 5-6

Offered weeks 1 - 9

Younger campers will enjoy mini-day trips, theme weeks, playing in our gym, ball/foam rooms, swimming pool, computer lab, arts & crafts, active games, and making friends.

Earth Watchers Ages 7-9

Offered weeks 1 - 9

Young campers explore through environmental studies of water, plants, wildlife and the weather. Located at the outdoor facility, Gail Graham ECO Park, activities may include fishing, group games, outdoor cooking, crafts, a weekly out trip and swimming at the Club.

Camp On Wheels (C.O.W) Ages 7-13

Offered weeks 1 - 9

This unique camp offers children the opportunity to travel throughout London and surrounding areas visiting a variety of attractions. Campers will enjoy out trips, swimming, large group games, arts and crafts, activities at the Club and special events.

Drama Rama Ages 7-13

Offered weeks 1, 3, 6, 8

Following a different script each week, these campers will shine as they learn the ins and outs of the theatre. Fun-filled activities include drama workshops, prop and set design, improvisation, group games, and swimming. At the end of each week, campers will entertain others with a special theatrical production. No previous acting experience required. Everyone is a star!

Arts Adventure Ages 7-13

Campers will explore, create, learn and experiment through drawing, painting and sculpture. Children are guided by their imagination as they work with different mediums to create their own masterpieces. Campers will also participate in group games, swimming and Afternoon Adventure at the Club.

Kamp I Direct - K.I.D. Ages 7-13

Offered weeks 1 - 9

Social Skills Camp Ages 8-11

Through specially designed programs focusing on real life competencies, children will develop age appropriate social skills, enhance peer relationships and build their self-esteem and confidence. A combination of activities including swimming, out trips, crafts, sports and games will provide children with valuable experience and life skills.

Camp ECO Ages 10-13

Offered weeks 1 - 9

This is the perfect camp for children who love nature and the great outdoors. Campers will spend time at the Gail Graham Eco Park (located on Medway Rd, east of Clarke Rd. Northeast London). Daily activities include swimming, hiking, environmental education, water sports, group games, arts and crafts plus a weekly out trip.

Youth who are interested in developing their leadership skills can sign up for this two week camp. Youth will gain front-line experience as assistants to staff counsellors during the second week when placed in one of the day camps.
