The Boys and Girls Club of London Foundation is instrumental in supporting the work of the Boys and Girls Club of London. It's with the Foundation's annual operating grant that the Club is helping young people, families and seniors realize their dreams, and receive important services.

The Club is relying on the Foundation now more than ever. Thanks to the leadership of the Foundation Board, and the guidance and direction of the Investment Committee, an operating grant of \$567,314 was provided to the Club. The Foundation also oversees any building improvements and capital purchases to support members and visitors.

The Foundation works side by side with the Club operating board, to establish priorities and goals, as was demonstrated by a new strategic plan. The new plan, established in 2020, prioritizes four main areas: Strong Club, Strong Communities, Strong Together and Strong Voice. This new plan will act as a roadmap for both organizations as we continue to be a leader in providing services to children, youth, families and seniors. Thank you to the Boards and staff who gave insight into this process.

The Foundation has continued its tradition of providing scholarships and grants to students who are part of the M.A.P. and education programs. This year, a new endowment was established, The David Grant Memorial Fund. David was a long time board member and instrumental in the establishment of the Foundation.

We would be remiss if we didn't speak to the way that the fiscal year in March 2020 came to a close and the onset of COVID-19. We were ready to host March Break day camps when we were faced with the difficult decision to cancel them, along with after-school and seniors' programs. At the time, we thought we would be putting things on hold for a few weeks or a month. As we have moved through this pandemic, obviously that wasn't the case. As a result, we had to make many difficult decisions which included putting some staff on leave.

While the annual report reflects and celebrates the accomplishments to the end of the fiscal year and our work up to the end of March, we must reflect on the impact that COVID-19 has had on the BGCL and the entire community. It's important to recognize how the BGCL rose to the challenge of continuing to support children, youth, seniors, and families during this time.

Transitioning to a virtual format was also made possible in a large part to the leadership of the Directors on the Club and Foundation. Decisions had to be made quickly and needed the thoughtful input of the Board.

Thank you to our funders, donors, and partners who support the Boys and Girls Club of London. Your kindness is making great work happen each day.

Thank you to staff Julio Cristales and Christina Yung, and all of the Foundation staff.
